Background

The energy industry and society at large are facing rapid changes which in part are due to the transition of energy from a hydrocarbon based commodity to one which has diverse sources with increasing elements of sustainability. Our whole economy is inevitably moving towards a circular, sustainable economy driven by our changing lifestyle.
