Programme Highlights

The new Scheme of Control Agreement between Power Utility Companies (i.e. CLP & HK Electric) and Hong Kong SAR Government will come into effect on 1 October 2018 and 1 January 2019 respectively. Under the agreement, both Companies will launch a number of new initiatives to encourage the community to embrace low-carbon lifestyles by promoting the development of renewable energy (RE) and energy conservation.

The purpose of this seminar is to introduce the details and application procedures for these new initiatives, including but not limited to the new Feed-in Tariff Scheme for Renewable Energy, Funding for Energy Improvement Projects, etc.
